

Galatians 5:22-25

²²But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

²⁴Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires. ²⁵Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

For the Student:

- Feeling **love** toward my classmates and teachers because God loves them
- Experiencing **joy** as I go through my daily tasks
- Being at **peace** with how God has chosen me to be
- Demonstrating **patience** when my classmates or teachers are a bit challenging
- Showing **kindness** toward classmates and teachers even if I mistakenly think they don't deserve it
- Being an example of **goodness** in a sea of nasty and negative attitudes
- Showing **faithfulness** toward my commitment to my studies
- Choosing **gentleness** which turns away wrath (always a good thing)
- Demonstrating **self-control** when I feel my frustrated or angry
